2. DESTINATION INFORMATION

Slovakia, officially the Slovak Republic, is a landlocked country situated in the heart of Central Europe. It was established on January 1, 1993 by the division of Czechoslovakia as a democratic parliamentary republic.

Slovakia is a member of the European Union, the Schengen Area, and NATO. The country covers 49,035 square kilometers, with an estimated population of approx. 5,5 mil. The capital and largest city is Bratislava, located 211 kilometers from Banská Bystrica.

The European Youth Olympic Festival (EYOF) is, without a doubt, the largest sporting event organized in Slovakia in its modern history.

Introducing Banská Bystrica

Banská Bystrica is a city in central Slovakia located on the Hron river in a long and wide valley encircled by the mountains. Thanks to its location, Banská Bystrica is considered the heart of Slovakia. At present, Banská Bystrica is the economic, administrative and cultural center of central Slovakia. With 78 327 inhabitants, Banská Bystrica is the sixth most populous municipality in Slovakia. The present town was founded by German settlers, however it was

built upon a former Slavic settlement. It obtained the municipal privileges of a free royal town of the Kingdom of Hungary in 1255. As a historical city with an easy access to the surrounding mountains, Banská Bystrica is a popular winter and summer tourist destination.

Sport has an important place in Banská Bystrica as Banská Bystrica was declared the European City of Sports 2017. Also Dukla Military Sports Center with its 5 Olympic winners, 15 world champions and 36 European champions is based in Banská Bystrica.

Useful Information

Weather Conditions

In Banská Bystrica, Zvolen and its region, the summers are comfortable, the winters are freezing and dry. Over the course of the year, the temperature typically varies from -6°C to 25°C and is rarely below 16°C or above 33°C. Based on the tourism score, the best time of the year to visit Banská Bystrica for warm-weather activities is from mid-June to late August.

Water

Slovakia is a country with one of best quality tap water in the world. Drinking tap water by using your own bottles is the best choice how to protect the environment and behave responsibly and sustainably. OC will provide each participant of EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 with stainless steel bottle. In each venue, which will be part of EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 (including accommodation facilities), there will be a self-service water pump for all participants.

Time Zone

Central European Time, 1 hour ahead of GMT; Summer time, which lasts from March to October, is 2 hours ahead of GMT, as in most European countries.

Currency

The official currency of Slovakia is Euro.

ATMs, Credit Cards and Banks Services

Major credit cards (American Express, Diners Club, VISA and Eurocard/Mastercard) and debit cards (Maestro and Visa Electron) may be used to withdraw cash from the ATMs of major banks (VUB, Tatra Banka, Slovenska Sporitelna) and for paying in hotels, restaurants, shops and petrol stations. Check with your credit card company for details of merchant acceptability and other available services.

Banking Hours: Banks in Slovakia are open Monday to Friday from 8:00 to 16:00. In larger cities they usually stay open until 18:00. While in the largest shopping centers, banks are also open on weekends, and until 20:00.

Electricity

Electricity in Slovakia is 230 V / 50 Hz, standard power plugs and sockets type C or type E.

Languages

The Slovak language is the official language of the Slovak Republic. English and German are the most often used foreign languages. Less frequent is the knowledge of French, Spanish, Italian or Russian. In the South of Slovakia, Hungarian is used frequently.

The official language of the EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 is English.

Communications and Mobile Networks

There are several mobile networks in Slovakia: Orange, Telekom, O2, 4Ka, Tesco Mobile. The cell service in the Banská Bystrica and Zvolen regions is stable and satisfactory. The 4G mobile internet is available.

Shopping - Opening Hours

Most shops are open Mondays to Fridays from 9:00 to 17:00. Smaller shops have lunch breaks. Big stores and shopping centers are typically open 7 days a week until 19:00 or 21:00. Tesco hypermarkets (also located in Banská Bystrica) are open 24 hours. Basic food can be bought in smaller shops (vecierka), open seven days a week and also at night.

Smoking and Alcohol Consumption

The minimum age for purchase and consumption of alcohol and tobacco is 18 years. Smoking and alcohol consumption are forbidden in the AVL buildings and catering tents. Smoking is forbidden in shops, restaurants, cafés, and sports facilities. The ban on smoking is indicated on information plates.

3. CUSTOMS AND VISAS

The Slovak Republic is part of the Schengen Area, where free movement of persons, goods, services and capital applies.

As for EU citizens, to enter Slovakia you need to have your passport or identity card. Children and minors must have their own passport / identity card. Please see the entry requirements for your delegation on the respective Slovak Embassy website.

From the 50 member states of the EOC only few members must complete the visa requirements: Republic of Armenia, Republic of Azerbaijan, Republic of Kosovo, Republic of Turkey. Participants from visa countries will be provided assistance in the visa process by the NOC Relations & Services Department.

4. EYOF BANSKÁ BYSTRICA 2022

The EYOF is the top multisport event open to young athletes of the National Olympic Committees, that are members of the European Olympic Committees, who have their 14th, 15th, 16th, 17th or 18th birthday during the year in which the respective EYOF is held based on valid age categories for each EYOF edition. EYOF is held every two years, in odd years, in both summer and winter editions.

EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022, as an organization, is a not-for-profit organization based in Banská Bystrica, Slovakia.

5. VOLUNTEERS

Just like at any other international sporting events, volunteers will play a very important role at EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022. They will be the face of the event and only thanks to them and their effort, we will be able to bring this event to a positive result. The number of volunteers who will participate in this event is 1500.

6. REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION

The Registration and Accreditation Process is the official process of registering NOC delegations and a prerequisite of participation at the European Youth Olympic Festival.

The respective NOC is the only authority that can register members of the delegation and provide all necessary data via the EOC Registration and Accreditation System (RAS),

The data in RAS including Sports Entries are the key data for the EYOF registration prevailing on any other data.

Conditions for participation and nationality of competitors (As per the [EYOF Charter](#)):

Participation in the European Youth Olympic Festival is open to all European young athletes nominated by their National Olympic Committee, subject to the current EYOF Charter and

EOC regulations on age categories and quotas published for each EYOF edition. The criteria for the qualification of athletes/teams are in the remit of the respective NOCs with the exception of team sports where the qualification systems /criteria are set up by the respective IF/EFs.

Any competitor in the EYOF must be a national or citizen of the country or territory of the NOC that is entering him/her or have the right of being a national or citizen of such country when the competitor reaches the legal age of majority. In any case, the NOC must, on the request of the Organising Committee (OC) or the EOC, duly approve the nationality, citizenship or right to obtain the one or the other by the competitor. An NOC that wishes to enter an athlete who does not meet these criteria, must submit a written and detailed request to the EYOF COCOM not later than four months before the date of the Opening Ceremony. The EYOF COCOM will make a recommendation to the EOC Executive Committee, which will at its sole discretion decide whether the request can be accepted or not.

The Deputy Chef de Mission is included in the GO quota

There is no special quota for the Covid liaison manager. Such person is to be appointed from the GO quota (somebody from medical personnel will carry out this role). This may be changed later based on the situation regarding actual Covid measures.

One media representative above the GO quota can be accredited within the delegation. He/she stays with the NOC delegation in the AVL.

The team officials (Ao) are entitled to enter their respective sport field of play only.

It is recommended to bring 2 Ao + 1 medical staff per team sport.

Entries by Number and by Name

The deadline for the Final Entries by Number (FEN) is 25 March 2022.

The second step in DRP can start, as soon as the OC activates the Long List for each delegation Opening RAS for Long List is planned for 15 April 2022.

There is no limitation for the number of persons entered in the Long List.

The RAS accepts both individual entries and bulk entries via the Excel spreadsheet template that can be downloaded from the RAS Intranet.

Short List and Sport Entries

After the Long List has been submitted by NOC and thereafter verified by the OC, the Short List registration will be opened.

When the Short List registration opens, the NOC must finalize the Sport entries and can place any registration from the Long List to the Short List. After a successful selection of the required number of delegation members, NOCs must submit the Short List by 9 July 2022. After this date, the RAS will be locked and further changes will not be allowed.

The Sport Entries process will be integrated and aligned with RAS. Furthermore, it allows an athlete to be registered for one or more events, according to the regulations of each sport. When registering athletes for events, in which they are planning to participate, NOCs will be required to add specific data to their sport entries.

The deadline for Sports Entries is 9 July 2022 as part of the Short list.

Late Athlete & Official Replacement

This policy will be applied in the period between the Short List deadline and the day of the Opening Ceremony (9 July through 24 July). Late replacement can be accepted when there

are medical conditions preventing the participation of an athlete or otherwise on an individual basis evaluated by EOC/OC.

Late Athlete Replacement would be possible only, provided that:

- the substitute (replacement) athlete is eligible to take part in the EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022
- the substitute athlete/official appears in the Long List
- the "Late Athlete Replacement Form" has been duly filled out by the relevant NOC, for the athlete being substituted, including explanation of such replacement
- completed Sport Entry for the substitute athlete has been submitted

7. INSURANCE

The EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 OC provides the following insurance coverages for dully accredited members of each NOC delegation:

- Third party liabilities insurance – cover to all claims for loss, personal injury and material damage. In case of wilful intent or gross negligence OC EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 insurance will not apply.
- Medical cost insurance – covers cost of medical treatment in case of illness, accident, hospitalization
- Individual Accident insurance – cover to permanent disability and death due to accident

The OC provides insurance to all participants at no charge.

Insurance is valid during the period from the official date of arrival till the official departure date. In case of hospitalisation the insurance covers all costs of medical treatment up to 10 days after the Closing Ceremony and the OC is responsible for eventual costs of her/his repatriation.

The OC nevertheless recommends all NOCs to insure their delegation members.

8. TRANSPORT

Arrivals and Departures by plane

The Milan Rastislav Štefánik Airport (Letisko Milana Rastislava Štefánika Bratislava), abbreviated as the Bratislava Airport (Letisko Bratislava, IATA: BTS, ICAO: LZJ) and Vienna-

Schwechat International Airport (Flughafen Wien-Schwechat, TA: VIE, ICAO: LOWW) are set as the official points of entry.

Bratislava airport is the international airport located 212km from Banská Bystrica, which is around 2.5 hours drive by bus.

Vienna- Schwechat International airport is the biggest airport in Austria and it is located 277km from Banská Bystrica and it will take you approximately 3 hours to get to Banská Bystrica from this airport.

Transportation from either of these airports to Banská Bystrica and back will be provided by coach busses and it will be free of charge.

NOCs has to submit their travel data into RAS by 20 June 2022, as well as an estimation of number of oversized luggage and volume of delegation equipment & stuff.



Arrivals and departures by car/bus

Participants arriving by own means of transport, please be informed of the need to pay toll for personal vehicles and buses on highways in Slovakia.

Vehicles

Vignettes in the Slovak Republic are in electronic form. They represent a fee for using the specified sections of highways and expressways. We recommend you to buy 10 days vignette valid for 10 days including the day specified by you. The cost of 10 days vignette for vehicle with a two-axle motor vehicle up to 3.5 tons and/or a two-axle motor vehicle of the M1

category regardless of its maximum technically permissible weight is 10 EUR. To buy the vignette please visit eznamka.sk/en.

Buses

There is a road toll system in the Slovakia: eMyto. All heavy goods vehicles and buses of over 3.5 tons using the whole, 2,400 km long Slovakian national road network (motorways and secondary roads) are subject to the payment of this road toll. For driving on the road network, the vehicle must be equipped with a specific device installed on board.

Transportation of Baggage, Equipment, and other devices

Accompanied luggage and equipment will be transported together with personal transfers. **Oversized equipment such as athletic poles and bicycles that will not fit in the coaches will be transported to Banská Bystrica with special vehicle at no surcharge. When providing A/D data it is necessary to state the amount and measurements of this oversized equipment. The detailed procedure of transfers of oversized luggage will be communicated to the NOCs in due time.**

Transport within Banská Bystrica



To promote environmentally friendly transportation, all participants of EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 will be able to use public transportation around Banská Bystrica free of charge. Moreover, there will be three EYOF 2022 shuttle bus lines operating between AVLs and Sport Park EYOF (the EYOF transport hub with main Transport mall) and other venues taking place in Banská Bystrica based on a fixed schedule.

Distances

Travel distances & times between AVLs, sports venues and catering tent are to be found in the [Appendix 8](#).

Parking Lots and Vehicle Access and Parking Permit (VAPP)

VAPPs will be available to NOCs in accordance with the parking capacity in each venue and AVLs, based on information about number of VAPP requests obtained from NOCs in RAS by 20 June. OC will evaluate all VAPPs requests after this deadline and will inform NOCs about the number of VAPPs they can grant to each NOC. VAPPs will allow access to the accredited parking areas in the venues and AVLs. VAPPs will be handed over to the CdM at the introductory one-on-one meeting.

Transport Information Desk

The NOC Service Center will provide information on transportation. One transportation desk will be in the Sport Park EYOF at the main Transportation Mall. EOC Family transportation desk will be located in the City Center of Banská Bystrica – main EOC Family Lounge.

NON-EYOF Local Transport Options

Even though venues and AVLs at the EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 are spread throughout Banská Bystrica, we highly recommend pedestrian access due to the short walking distances.

All public transportation within the city and railways connecting the venues will be free of charge for all accredited persons.

Moreover, there will be a recommended Taxi service. The number for the Taxi service will be available on the brochures with the city map.

9. ACCOMMODATION

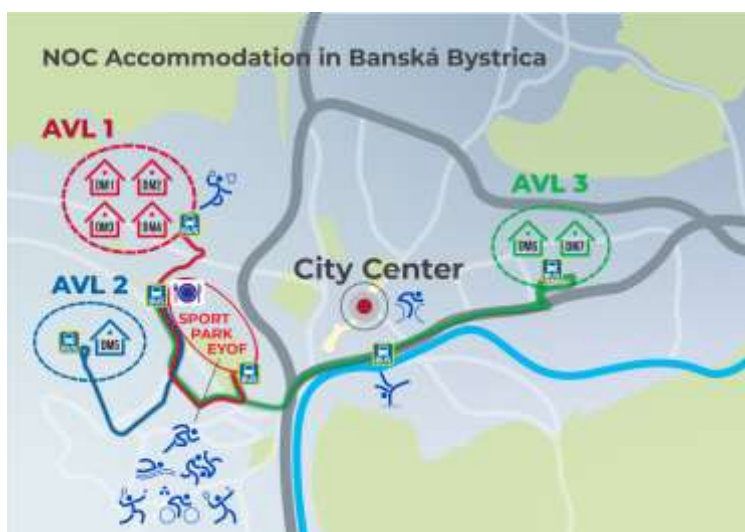
The Athletes Villages (AVLs) during the European Youth Olympic Festival are located in the cities Banská Bystrica and Zvolen. Three AVLs (AVL 1, 2, 3) will be located in Banská Bystrica and one (AVL 4) in the City of Zvolen. The distance between Banská Bystrica and Zvolen is 25 km and it takes approximately 20 minutes by car. Accommodation is located at the university and high school dormitories. These four AVLs consist all together of 8 dormitories (buildings).

AVL 4 is located to City of Zvolen. It consists of one building with capacity of 408 beds. This AVL will accommodate both Handball boys' and girls' teams and Volleyball boys' teams. The

main reason for such decision is the fact, that sports venues for Handball boys and Volleyball boys are located in Zvolen only 2,7 km and 7 minutes drive from the AVL 4. Handball girls sport hall is located in Detva, which is a nearby city to Zvolen 25,7 km and 21 minutes drive from the AVL 4.

Location of AVLs Dormitories DM1 – DM8

The location of the individual dormitories is displayed on the map. There will be shuttle buses connecting AVLs with all venues.



Services

Accommodation desks

There will be Accommodation desk in each Dormitory (DM 1 – DM 8) dealing with various requests and questions regarding accommodations, cleaning services, laundry, repairing service etc. These desks will be operated daily: 22 – 30 July 2022, 07:00-22:00

Housekeeping

Emptying bins and cleaning of sanitary facilities will be carried out daily. Hygiene needs will be replenished (toilet paper, soap). Please note: waste sorting bins (plastic, paper, mixed) will be located into entrance area on the ground floor.

Cleaning services and a handyman will have access to the room daily: 23 – 30 July 2022, 07:00-15:00

With respect to the pursuit of global environmental sustainability used towels and bed sheets, if necessary, can be changed for clean ones in the Accommodation desk at each dormitory daily: 23 – 30 July 2022, 07:00-09:00/19:00-22:00

Laundry

Free of charge laundry facilities (washing machines including washing gel) are available for athletes and officials at the AVLs 1-4 daily: 24 –30 July2022, 07:00-22:00

Laundry drying racks will be available on request at Accommodation desk. Iron and ironing board are not available.

10. CATERING

The EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 Catering Services will provide food and drinks services, with an emphasis on high quality, good availability and variety of dishes. The service will demonstrate respect to the environment, national practices, considering the ethnic, religious, dietary and nutritional needs of all participants.

Catering tent

During the EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 the largest amount of catering services will be provided in catering tent located in the center of the Sport Park EYOF and thus in the area with the largest movement of participants. Catering services in this tent will provide full board catering options for the athletes and officials with capacity 1300 people at time. All participants are entitled to get 3 meals a day, Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. For those who finish their competition/match later in the evening and don ´t get Dinner, Late Dinner will be available from 22:00 till 23:00.

The opening hours of the Catering Tent are as follows:

- Breakfast: 6:00–10:00
- Lunch: 11:00–15:00
- Dinner: 17:00–22:00
- Late Dinner: 22:00–23:00

The catering tent will include a controlled entrance, seating at the tables, self-service islands with refreshments, ice service, a food counters with service and non-stop cleaning service. The operation of the tent will start on 23 July 2022 for lunch and will end on 31 July 2022 with breakfast.

Catering in AVL3

Due to the greater distance from the main catering tent, breakfast for participants staying at the AVL 3 (DM6, DM7) will be provided directly in the dining hall of the dormitory DM7. The breakfast served here will be as close as possible to the breakfast served in the catering tent during EYOF 2022.

Other meals such as lunch and dinner will be served in the catering tent.

Catering in Sports Venues

There will be water & ice service in each venue. In some of the venues there will be also light refreshment based on the specific sport needs.

Catering for NOCs

Catering for NOCs will be prepared with emphasis on the needs of athletes, quality and safety.

Each dish will be photographed and its picture posted in the Catering Tent or catering venue with detailed composition how much fat (and saturated fat), carbohydrate (and sugar), protein, and salt per 100 g of the given food contains. Allergenic ingredients will also be highlighted. Athletes suffering from allergy to certain foods may individually compose their dietary meals from the available dishes.

11. SPORT

Sport Information Centre and Desks

The Organising Committee will set up several Sport Information Desks, where those interested will find information, relating to all sports, daily from 7:00 through 22:00, including start lists, results, competition and training schedules, etc. Sport information desks will be located in:

- NOC Services Centres (NOCSC) in each AVL
- Hotel Dixon (DIX)
- Hotel Tennis (TEN) in Zvolen

Official training day and pre-EYOF training

24 July 2022 is the first official training date at the EYOF competition and training venues. The Organising Committee does not provide any training slots nor training camps prior to this date.

Water and Ice Supplies

The Organising Committee will provide access to drinking water for the athletes at every competition venue and at each venue, which will be part of EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 (including accommodation facilities), there will be a self-service water pump for all participants. OC will provide each participant of EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 with stainless steel bottle.

In addition to water, volunteers will also assist the athletes and officials with having access to ice in all competitions venues.

Clothing/advertising

In accordance with the EYOF Charter, Rule 20 and the By-laws to Rule 20, no form of advertising or publicity, other than that specified below, may appear in any form whatsoever on clothing, accessories or, more generally, on any item of clothing or piece of equipment worn or carried by the delegations and organizers during EYOF, with the exception of the following:

One (1) manufacturer's identification AND one (1) NOC sponsor logo of no more than 30 cm² EACH can be displayed on each piece of non-competition clothing.

One (1) manufacturer's identification AND one (1) NOC or NF (subject to the approval of the respective NOC) sponsor logo of no more than 30 cm² EACH can be displayed on each piece of competition uniform and equipment in accordance with valid IF/EF rules (*In case of a discrepancy between the EOC and EF rules concerning the use of commercial logos on competition clothing, the rule, which is more restrictive in each specific case prevails*).

The only exceptions to the size restrictions are the graphics or graphic elements of the manufacturers' brand on the official uniforms/equipment that may exceed the restricted size; e.g., three stripes, fluege.de (and similar cases of "commercial brand graphics element") that can be tolerated and accepted.

No alcohol or tobacco producers' logos, no betting companies' logos, or the logos of any other sponsors that can damage the image of the EOC and/or Olympic Movement in general will be allowed.

Each use of a sponsor's logo has to be approved by the EOC in writing. The NOC must send pictures featuring such logo to the EOC Head Office (eoc@eurolympic.org) for review and official approval.

All violations of the provisions of this clause shall lead to disqualification and the withdrawal of the accreditation of the person/s concerned.

The NOCs are requested to bring a sample of the competition uniform to the first Technical meeting of each sport for final check in order to avoid any problems on the field of play.

The official uniforms of the NOCs may also include:

- Symbols of the country (name of the country, national flag, emblem, etc.)
- Emblem of the NOC
- Logo of the EYOF 2022
- Emblem of the respective National Sport Federation

Please note that the NOC is responsible for the appearance of the official uniforms.

Start and results Service

EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 will implement centralized Results services. Results and all relevant sports data will be available on results.eyof2022.com

Data and timing systems

OC will provide a computerized Data & Timing & Scoring and Results Service approved by the respective sport's European Federation.

Start bibs and other equipment

OC will be responsible for the Start Bibs and any other identification of athletes and coaches, for start and finish installations and other sport equipment in the venues.

Competition schedule changes

During the 2022 EYOF there may be delays, postponements or cancellations of the competition programme. Should this occur, NOCs will inform of the revised tournament schedule through the Sport Information Centers and via dedicated WhatsApp group for each sport.

Judges

In Athletics, judges are provided by the OC, together with the Slovak Athletic Federation.

12. TECHNICAL INFORMATION

All athletics events will take place on the newly reconstructed Athletics stadium, the SportPark Athletics (SPA), with the new warm up stadium right next to the competition venue. The training field has 4 lanes oval and 6 lines straights and whole athletics venue is the part of the Sport Park EYOF.

13. GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF THE ATHLETICS COMPETITION

The athletics competition will be organised and conducted in accordance with the actual WA rules and regulations.

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will be held on Sunday 24 July 2022, at 11:00 in the VIP room (tribune inside). Two representatives from each delegation (and an interpreter if necessary) can be present for the meeting.

The procedure of the Technical Meeting

The technical meeting will be led by the European Athletics (EA) Technical Delegates, Competition director, NTO representatives and will be conducted in English language.

The Agenda of the Technical meeting

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Written Questions

Participating teams can submit questions concerning the competition which would be answered in the process of the Technical Meeting. The forms for written questions will be available during accreditation. These forms must be returned to the TIC (Technical Information Center), latest by Saturday 23 July 2022 18:00.

Participation

There will be 20 boys' events and 20 girls' events.

Each NOC may enter a maximum of 28 athletes for the athletics programme. Each NOC may also enter one official for every four athletes entered (with a maximum of six officials). Each NOC may enter only one athlete per event. Athletes are not allowed to participate in more than two individual events (not counting relays). If these two individual events are track events, only one of them may exceed 200m. Athletes may compete only in the relay event, but must be included within the maximum size of the team. The names of the athletes participating in the relay teams (in running order) must be submitted to the Technical Information Centre (TIC) not later than 60 minutes prior to the first call time of the first heat of the respective round.

Limited number of implements will be available at the warm up field. Personal Implements will also be allowed, providing that:

- They have valid WA certification
- They are not already on the official list
- They are in good conditions and the brand is easily recognized.
- They are made available to all the other competitors until the end of the final

Personal implements will have to be submitted to TIC the day before the event no later than 18:00. For events taking place on the first day of the competition, implements shall be handed in on Sunday 24 July 2022 between 11:00 and 17:00. Personal implements will be handed back at the TIC after the end of the respective competition. In case the personal implements are rejected, the team leader will be informed accordingly as soon as possible by the TIC.

16. VAULTING POLES PROCEDURE

Each team is responsible for organising the transport of vaulting poles to Bratislava or Vienna airport. The OC is responsible for transporting the vaulting poles to the training venue. Upon arrival athletes are responsible for taking their vaulting poles to the 2022 EYOF Welcome Desk at the airport. Vaulting poles will then be transported to the training venue by the OC.

The procedure for handing in vaulting poles is as follows:

- All athletes collect their vaulting poles at the 'odd sizes' baggage desk before going through customs.
- All athletes with vaulting poles will hand over their poles to the OC at the 2022 EYOF Welcome desk at Bratislava or Vienna Airport.
- Vaulting poles bags will be tagged with the name of the athlete, country and the discipline/gender.
- A receipt with the name, country, the discipline/gender, the departure date and time and number of vaulting poles will be given to the athlete.
- A copy of the receipt will be kept by the OC for the return of the vaulting poles upon departure.
- The OC will deliver the vaulting poles to the Warm-up venue - Training Stadium Athletics (TAT).
- The vaulting poles will be transported to the competition venue the evening before the event (18:00).
- After the event the vaulting poles will be transported back to the training venue, so the poles are available for the training the next day.

The OC will transport the vaulting poles from the training venue to Bratislava or Vienna Airport on the athletes' departure date. Athletes will pick up their poles at the transport desk (Welcome desk) at Bratislava or Vienna Airport located in departure hall.

Volunteers will escort the athletes to the poles.

17. PRE-COMPETITION PROCEDURE

Warm-up before events

Warm-up before the events can take place at the warm up track (6 Lanes straight / 4 oval) alongside the athletics stadium. Long throws are allowed at the warm-up venue based on prepared timetable programme due to safety reasons.

Call Rooms 1/2

There will be two Call Rooms for the participants.

The Call Room 1 will be located at the Warm-up venue, TAT. All athletes must report directly at the Call Room 1. It is the responsibility of the coaches to ensure that their athletes are aware of the final check-in times at the Call Room 1. Call Room 1 is just a „meeting point“, all athletes will be accompanied by organizers to the Call Room 2, since they will need to walk short distance.

Control of the compliance with the WA Competition and the EOC Advertising Rules will be performed in the Call room 2, on the following:

- Competition clothing
- Shoes
- Advertising
- Any non-authorized equipment (radio, iPod, mobile phone, camera etc.) will be confiscated at the Call Room and may NOT be taken onto the field of play.

Competitors ´ Uniform Check-Up

All the competitors must wear a national team uniform (TR5.1). The uniform will be compared with the team uniform photo submitted before the event. The competitors wearing other than the official uniform will be requested to put on the official uniform prior to leaving the call room, otherwise they might be excluded from the competition. Competitors in relay races must all wear the same uniform.

Inspection of Personal Belongings

Thorough check of personal belongings will be conducted in the Call room 2. Any personal belongings (such as tape-recorders, radio, mobile phones, MP3 players, video cameras, etc.) forbidden to be taken to the field of play by WA rules will be confiscated in the Call room 2. All objects confiscated from the competitors will be returned at the TIC after the event.

Athletes must report to the Call Room 1 before each event as follows:*

A more detailed Call Room schedule will be composed and announced as soon as the final entries are confirmed.

It is possible these times may be changed if the entries require and these changes will be communicated latest at the technical meeting.

When leaving the Call Room 2, a Call room manager announces the warning signal verbally (with megaphone if needed) 3 minutes and 1 minute before leaving the call room and then athletes will be directed into the start area by the organizer, to prepare for the race.

18. WA Athletics Shoe Regulations

Dimensions and number of Spikes

The sole and heel of the shoes shall be so constructed as to provide for the use of up to 11 spikes. The part of each spike which projects from the sole or the heel shall not exceed 9 mm except in the High Jump and Javelin throw, where it shall not exceed 12 mm. The spike must be so constructed that it will, at least for the half of its length closest to the top, fit through a square sided 4 mm gauge.

The Sole and the Heel

The sole and/or heel may have grooves, ridges, indentations or protuberances, provided these features are constructed of the same or similar material to the basic sole itself. Concerning the maximum thickness of the sole see Appendix 3 of the WA Athletics Shoe Regulations.

Sample of the shoe declaration form can be found in the [Appendix 7](#).

Bibs

The OC will provide the teams with bibs at the Technical Meeting. Each competitor will receive four bibs. The athlete's personal bibs shall be pinned on to the front of the torso and back (except in the Jumping events, where one bib may be worn on the chest or back only), on the back of the tracksuit and on the bag. The bibs may not be cut, bent or covered in any way whatsoever.

Each runner in a relay team must wear the bib with the official three-letter country code of his/her national federation on the front. On the back the runner must wear his/her personal bib.

Hip Numbers

Athletes competing in track events will also be given two adhesive hip numbers in the call room before entering the field. The hip numbers must be secured to each leg of the athlete.

Competition Format

Final Confirmation

For the first competition day all teams must make final confirmations until 24 July 2022, 16:00 at the TIC. For the other competition days, final confirmation must be made the day before the competition until 12:00 (noon) at the TIC.

Track Events

Running events shall be implemented in accordance with WA TR20 and shall be decided depending on the number of participants in each event.

Each country may declare one team for each relay run. The number of team members can reach six athletes, as soon as the team is entered into the competition only two additional athletes can participate in the following stages by way of substitution. The substitutes shall be appointed from the list of athletes declared for entering the competition (relay run or any other event). Nevertheless, any athlete having been allowed to compete after qualification either in the qualification stage of any event or in a race but not participated in that very event for no good reason (e.g. medical certificate issued by the official physician of track and field event), cannot be declared as a substitute for relay (WA TR4 and TR24).

Field Events

Qualification standards for the field events will be established by European Athletics technical delegates based on the final entries and announced at the technical meeting latest.

Twelve (12) or more athletes who met the qualification standards will qualify for the finals. In case the number of athletes who met the qualification standards will be less than twelve (12) the group of finalists shall be enlarged with the athletes having shown the best results in the qualification round. In case of a tie for entering the following round of competitions (a tie at determining the last result coming into the following round) and if two or more athletes have a tie according to the results of the qualification round, TR25.22 or TR26.8 resp. is used to determine the last eliminatory place for entry if necessary. Provided a tie having been established, all athletes with equal results are qualified for entry in the following (final) round of competitions.

Starting heights and the raising of the bar in high jump and pole vault shall be established by the European Athletics Technical Delegates and will be announced at the Technical meeting latest.

The participant must inform the judge of the position of the crossbar he requires for his first trial and this position shall be recorded. If subsequently an athlete wants to make any changes, he should immediately inform the judge before the crossbar has been set in accordance with his initial wishes. Failure to do this shall lead to the start of his time limit.

Starting Commands

Starting commands will be announced in English. The following commands will be given at distances up to and including 400 m:

- On your marks!
- Set!
- Shot

At distances including 800 m and longer:

- On your marks!
- Shot

If for any reason the starter feels it is necessary to interrupt the starting process, he will say:

- "Stand Up"

False start indicators will be installed on the starting blocks.

Timing

Timing system shall be furnished with video monitoring system, and fully automated anticipation of the start system.

Measurements

The measurements in all horizontal jumps and throwing events will be done by using electronic distance measurement device. Measurements in vertical jumps will be done manually.

Authorized Equipment

European Athletics Technical Delegates have authorized the list of the equipment used in the competitions, it can be found at the implement list section (Appendix 3).

The Organising Committee provide all authorized equipment for trainings and competition. An athlete may use his own equipment in case if they do not contravene the appropriate WA TR32.2. This equipment may also be subsequently used by other competitors.

Run Markers

Athletes will not be permitted to use their own markers during the competitions. Those athletes wishing to use a marker may only use the markers provided by the OC at the event site. Officials will provide adhesive tape for athletes participating in the relays (one mark) and high jump. The athletes competing in long/triple jump, pole vault and javelin can use up to two markers.

Competition Preparation

For field events OC will provide appropriate baskets for athletes bags and tracksuits.

In running events, baskets will be provided based on the weather conditions, preference is step in to the field ready to race. In case of bad weather conditions, tracksuits will be put in baskets at the start.

Baskets will be taken to the Kit Collection area located under the main tribune.

Post competition Information

All athletes must leave the infield through mixed zone. In the mixed zone representatives of the media may ask for a brief interview. After passing through the mixed zone the athletes move directly on to the Kit Collection Area.

Order of leaving the arena

Running competition:

athletes will leave the field of play right after finishing

Field events:

in the qualification: athletes leave together after the end of the qualification

in the final: after the 3rd attempt the athletes will leave the field of play with OC staff, best 8 competitors leave the field of play together after the end of the final

High jump and pole vault:

the competitors leave the field of play through mixed zone with an accompanying person as soon as they drop out of the contest but three best competitors must leave together



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Mixed Zone

The athletes having left the mixed zone will not be allowed to go back there in.

Information during the competition

Field events

All intermediate results and ranking of the athletes during the competition will be shown on electronic displays in the appropriate sector.

Running competition

At distances exceeding 400 m intermediate times results for the leader will be shown at the following marks:

800m - after 400m

1500m - after 400m, 800m and 1200m

3000m - after each 1000m

Steeplechase - after each 1000m

General Information

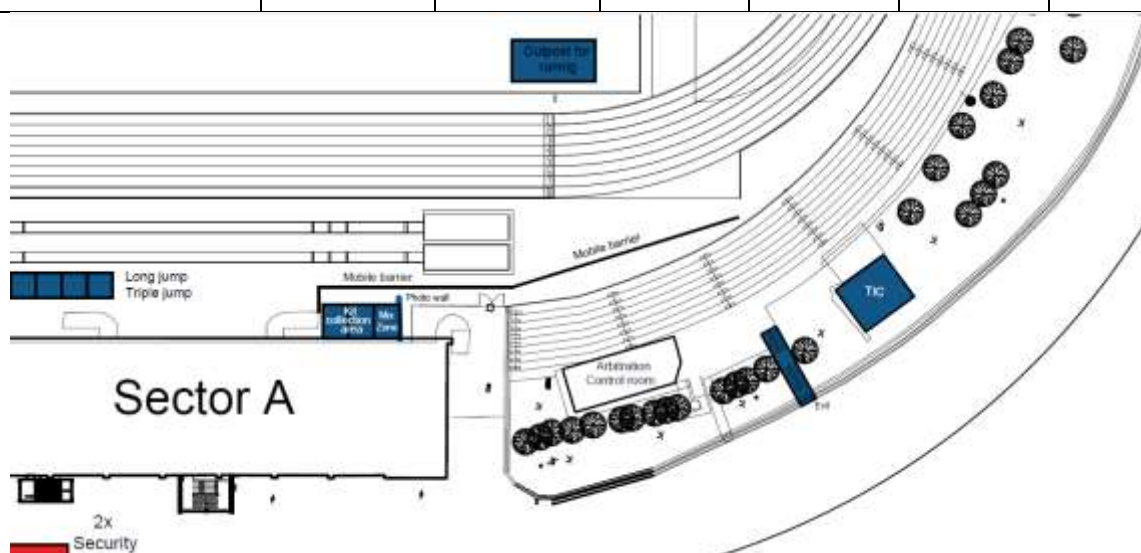
In finals all the athletes shall be presented to the spectators one-by-one before the start. The medalists may take a victory lap.

Technical Information Centre (TIC)

The TIC is located at the tribune of the competition venue (beside main tribune). The main function of the centre is to ensure a smooth liaison between each team, the Local Organising Committee, European Athletics technical delegates and the competition management regarding technical matters.

TIC Duties

The TIC is responsible for, but not limited to, the following:

- Displaying official communications to the teams on the relevant notice board, including start lists, results and call room reporting times
- Distributing urgent notices to the delegations from the technical delegates and

competition management via the pigeon boxes (one for each country). It is the Team Leader's duty to collect this information regularly on time.

- Collecting technical enquiries from delegations
- Receiving final confirmations
- Distributing and receiving relay order confirmation forms
- Distributing special passes the day before the respective event, according to start list
- Registering and collecting personal implements (shot put, etc.)
- Managing national record doping control requests
- Receiving withdrawal forms
- Managing written appeals
- Communicating the victory ceremonies schedule
- Distributing items confiscated at the Call Room

Results

The results will be published in English. The results as well as the programme for the following day will be made available at the NOC Services Centre (NOCSC), in the competition venue at the Technical Information Centre (TIC) as well as at the official EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 website: results.eyof2022.com

Protests

Chair of Jury of Appeal: Roosen Marcellus (NED)

Protests and appeals are permitted and will be processed in accordance with WA TR8. In the first instance, protests must be made orally to the Referee by the athlete himself/herself or by someone acting on his/her behalf or by an official representative of a team (WA TR8.3). Such person or team may protest only if they are competing in the same round of the event to which the protest (or subsequent appeal) relates.

Where the appropriate Referee is not accessible or available, the protest should be made to him through the TIC. Protests concerning the result or conduct of an event shall be made within 30 minutes of the official announcement of the result of that event (posted on the TIC information board).

If the Referee makes a decision a written appeal can be submitted to the Jury of Appeal also through the TIC. Protest forms can be obtained from TIC. Any written appeal to the Jury of Appeal must be made in accordance with WA TR8.7 and signed by a responsible official on behalf of the athlete and submitted to TIC within 30 minutes after the official announcement of the decision made by the Judge.

When submitting an appeal form, the rules require the payment of a €100 deposit. If the protest is unsuccessful, the deposit will not be returned. The jury's decision will be provided in writing. Please note that the LOC can only accept cash payment.

Withdrawal

Withdrawals after final confirmation, have to be submitted, on the official Withdrawal Form, to the TIC. If the athlete is entered in another event of the competition, the reason for the withdrawal has to be specified in detail and confirmed by the Medical Delegate of the OC; its acceptance being the responsibility of the Technical Delegates based on the WA Rules.

Exclusion of Athletes

As set out in TR4.4, competitors will be excluded from all further events in the EYOF including relays in the following cases:

- If their participation in an event was confirmed (and the confirmation was not cancelled before the deadline of the confirmations) but they failed to take part without giving a valid reason. Normally that reason should be confirmed by the Medical Delegate or the official Doctor of the competition. The reason for not participating must be submitted to the TIC prior to the Call Room deadline for the event.
Medical excuse confirmation form will be available in TIC.
- If they qualified in a preliminary round of an event but failed to take part in the next round without giving a valid reason. The reason for not participating must be submitted to the TIC prior to the Call Room deadline for the event. The justification of the reason for not participating in all cases must be approved by the Technical Delegate.

19. VENUE FACILITIES

Venue facilities were recently built; the athletic track was completed in 2021. They are in a walking distance from accommodation.

Athletics village 1 – DM1, DM2, DM3, DM4 = 1,5/1,8km

Athletics village 2 – DM5 = 1,8km

Athletics village 3 – DM6, DM7 = 3km

Competition Area: Sport Park Athletics (SPA)

Track surface: Conipur M (track + sectors of technical events) + Conipur EPDM SP (side areas)

The stadium has the following competition sites:

- 8 Lanes
- 2 High Jump areas
- 2 Pole Vault areas
- 4 Long/Triple Jump pits
- 2 Shot Put Circles
- 1 Combined Discus/Hammer Circle
- 2 Javelin sites

Warm-Up Area: Training Stadium Athletics (TAT)

Track surface: Conipur SP (track) + Coniur SW (sectors)

The warm up area has the following sites:

- 6 Lanes straight / 4 oval
- 1 High Jump area
- 1 Pole Vault area
- 2 Long/Triple Jump pits
- 1 Shot Put Circle
- 1 Combined Discus/Hammer Circle
- 1 Javelin site

All training sessions shall be held at warm-up area according to the training schedule, [Appendix 2](#).

Training times per disciplines for throwing events may be changed after the final entries.

Training with official starters will take place on 24 July 11:15 until 12:30 at the competition venue.

Throwing areas at warm-up stadium (Discus, Hammer and Javelin) can be used just in a scheduled warm-up/training time, because of safety reasons.

Weightlifting room – GYM

A weightlifting room (GYM) will be available in a tent near the starting line at the warm-up area.

Team Tents

Team tents will be placed alongside the warm-up track, see the [Appendix 6](#).

Venue Inspection Visits

The team leaders official venue inspection visits will be on 24 July 2022 at 9:30 a.m. before the Technical Meeting, to show the arrangement of main service zones, warm-up areas, call and registration rooms, interview room, etc. Please refer to the TIC for more detailed information.

20. MEDICAL ISSUES AND ANTI-DOPING

Medical Services Concept

The provision of medical and rescue services is a key for success and successful management of the event. The Medical Manager of EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 with the medical team, in supervision by the EOC Medical Delegate will take care of the health of participants. Medical services will include the provision of free of charge healthcare for all accredited groups involved in the EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022.

Healthcare and health services will be provided at the Main Medical Center (MMC), located in the Dukla Banská Bystrica building in the Sport Park EYOF near the shuttle bus stop Sport Park (west entrance to the Sport Park EYOF). Health services will also be provided at competition and non-competition venues. Medical services in the event of an accident and life threatening situation will be provided by the emergency services, professional medical staff and students of the medical departments of the university, directly on the site of sports fields, training areas and spectator sectors. Further necessary health care as well as specialized care will be provided in cooperation with the official partner hospitals EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 in Banská Bystrica Children's University Hospital and in F.D. Roosevelt University General Hospital of Banská Bystrica.

Healthcare will be provided from 23 July 2022 to 31 July 2022.

Medical Services

All other medical services provided – life threatening situations and sudden deterioration of health, will be solved during the competition, with on-site emergency services and medical staff. Outside the competition, the provision of health care will be carried out through the health dispatching on the number +421 902 959 869 (0-24).

Medications to handle basic situations will be available at the Main Medical Center.

The pharmacy service will be provided according to the [current schedule of emergency pharmacies](#), or in the F.D. Roosevelt University General Hospital of Banská Bystrica.

All requests for special examinations, laboratory sampling and other requirements will be addressed through the medical dispatch centre on the number +421 902 959 869 (0-24).

Further information about medical services, Medical Centre, Pharmacy, Dental service and important information about medical services during EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 will be detailed in the Medical Handbook that will be sent to all NOCs by 15 May 2022.

Anti-doping

Doping control rules and program

Athletes always have the right to participate in sports without doping. The purpose of doping control is to ensure the right of athletes to fair and clean competition. At EYOF, many young athletes have their first experience with anti-doping activities, so doping control procedures are carefully planned and well implemented, and doping controls have an educational aspect. Doping controls and other anti-doping activities are part of the careers of elite athletes, it's time to learn them.

Doping control stations

The Main Doping control station is located in Dukla Banská Bystrica building in the Sport Park EYOF next to the Shuttle service bust stop Sport Park (west entrance to the Sport Park EYOF) – the same place as the Main Medical Center. There will be also one doping station in Zvolen, at the Volleyball venue.

Collection of samples

Responsibility for sampling for EYOF has been delegated to the Slovak Anti-Doping Agency (SADA). According to the EOC Anti-Doping Rules and the ISTI International Standard for Testing and Investigation it is possible to take doping samples during the EYOF, during and outside the competition. Urine and blood tests are possible, so athletes must be familiar with both doping test procedures and their rights and responsibilities during the doping test. All athletes have the right to have a doping test representative with them. It is very important for minors to have an adult with them. Bottled water and soft drinks will be available for athletes at the doping control station, but no food. Athletes or their support staff can bring food for athletes if needed. Upon completion of the doping control, athletes and their

representatives will be provided with transportation to accommodation from the doping control location.

Doping samples will be analysed in an accredited laboratory of the World Anti-Doping Agency in Seibersdorf, Austria.

Therapeutic Use Exemption

All Athletes and Athlete Support Staff must be familiar with the Prohibited List. If an Athlete has diseases or conditions that require the use of medications that are prohibited, the Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) may grant him or her permission to take the required medication. Athletes and their support staff must be aware of the EOC TUE recognition process and the TUE application process.

Any Athlete who is taking any medication and using the treatment listed in the WADA Prohibition List must submit a TUE application to his or her National Anti-Doping Office at least 30 days prior to the competition. National TUE permits must be approved by the TUE Committee of the European Olympic Committee, accompanied by the relevant medical documentation in English. TUE must be sent to medcom@eurolympic.org by 24 June 2022.

Covid-19 Terms

Entry to Slovakia

There is no restrictions related to entering Slovakia in terms of Covid -19 at this point, the OC will closely monitor situation and will inform you in case of any changes. However, as the situation is evolving we strongly advice to consult korona.gov.sk for up to date information on Covid-19 related matters.

21. IT

Internet and Wi-Fi

There will be free internet connection in all AVLs. It will be a mixture of Wi-Fi and cable internet. Wi-Fi hotspots will be available in each dormitory lobby. Login details will be provided for each accommodation.

Every venue will have small sub-media corner where you can find cable and Wi-Fi internet.

EYOF wireless hotspots speed should be limited, so it can't be used for transferring and uploading large data files, such as movies, photos, etc. Access to some internet services may be restricted.

Mobile network and mobile internet

Slovakia is an EU member; therefore same rules apply when using mobile phone as at home network, for calling and internet use for EU Member Countries participants (check EU regulations). In Banská Bystrica 4G network is available and internet speed depends on coverage. 4G Networks provide useful and stable internet connection for all roaming users as well. If you are not from EU, you can buy a prepaid card from Slovak operators. That cards offer calling and mobile data.

Mobile operators in Slovakia are Orange, Telekom, O2, 4Ka, Tesco Mobile. SIM cards can be easily bought in regular shops.

Radio frequency assignment and registration

Any equipment which is not using free range of frequencies must have Individual permission from REGULATORY AUTHORITY FOR ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION. NOCs are responsible for such arrangements. For more details please check: www.teleoff.gov.sk/.

22. SECURITY

Basic Information

Banská Bystrica as a host city, together with Zvolen and Detva, are safe European cities, where the general sense of public order is widely perceived.

In the Slovak Republic, Act No. 1/2014 was adopted, regulating the organization of sports and cultural events. The OC must follow this decree when organizing the EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022.

A Security Commission (SC) has been established within the Organising Committee to address all security challenges and ensure crisis management if necessary.

The members of the SC are also representatives of the Police of the Slovak Republic, the Military Police, city police, the Private Security Service (PSS), and a group of volunteers.

Cadets of the Academy of Police Force and the Academy of the Armed Forces of the Slovak Republic will also serve as volunteers at EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022.

The main goal is to ensure a high level of security and safety of athletes and visitors while maintaining an enjoyable ambiance for each participant to experience this very important Event.

A Security Services Center will be operating 24/7 and will serve as an operational center for the management of the security situation, the Fire and Rescue Corps, the Medical Service, the Security Service, and the Civil Protection. Operators will continuously evaluate the output from the camera system, which will cover all important points and areas of the EYOF. The CCTV system is set up to increase security and for the needs of the Police in the event of criminal or misdemeanor proceedings.

Emergency Information

In the case of extraordinary events, the necessary information will be communicated to the NOCs via all channels of communication.

All participants have designated points of emergency contact at every security checkpoint which is connected with the Security Service Centre. Nevertheless, the number to reach the Integrated Emergency helpline is: 112

23. CEREMONIES

Opening and Closing Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony will take place on Sunday, 24 July, starting at 20:30 in the park close to the SNP (Slovak National Uprising) Memorial – the official EYOF Fan zone location.

The Closing Ceremony will take place on Saturday, 30 July, starting at 20:30 in the official EYOF Fan zone - at the same location as the Opening Ceremony.

Victory Ceremonies and Medal Awards

The EYOF Victory Ceremonies will take place at the competition venue for each sport and discipline in line with the Summer EYOF Ceremonies Guidelines. The dates and times will be indicated in the daily competitions' schedule.

At the ceremonies, a medal and a mascot will be presented to the gold, silver and bronze medalists. Victory Ceremonies will include all obligatory elements and protocol such as

playing of the national anthem of the winning athlete(s), raising the national flags (on a digital screen) and medal decoration of the athletes.

Victory Ceremonies will be conducted in English and Slovak. Participation in the Victory Ceremonies is limited to medal-winners and presenters.

Medal-winning athletes must wear their official NOC uniforms. During the Victory Ceremony, accreditation cards must either be temporarily handed over to the Victory Ceremonies staff or kept out of sight. No participant should have flags, signs, items of sport equipment or other personal items such as mobile phones, cameras, electronic devices, water bottles with them during the Victory Ceremony.

Each medalist will also receive a victory diploma and a medal pouch, which can be picked up by the Chef de Mission or Deputy Chef de Mission at the NOC Services Centre the day after medal ceremony. The victory diplomas of the medal winners competing on the last day of the EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 (30 July 2022) may be picked up from the NOC Services Centre prior to their departure.

24. MEDIA, PRESS

Media Services

The EYOF Banská Bystrica 2022 offers an appropriate level of Media Operations. There are basic facilities and a comfortable working environment for all the accredited members of different media – printed, online, audio-visual and photo journalists. We guarantee a professional and enjoyable atmosphere for the media and athletes.

Broadcasting/Streaming

In cooperation with TV broadcaster a live streaming from selected sports will be provided.

The motto aims to express the significance of every single athlete as the potential Olympic champions of the future.

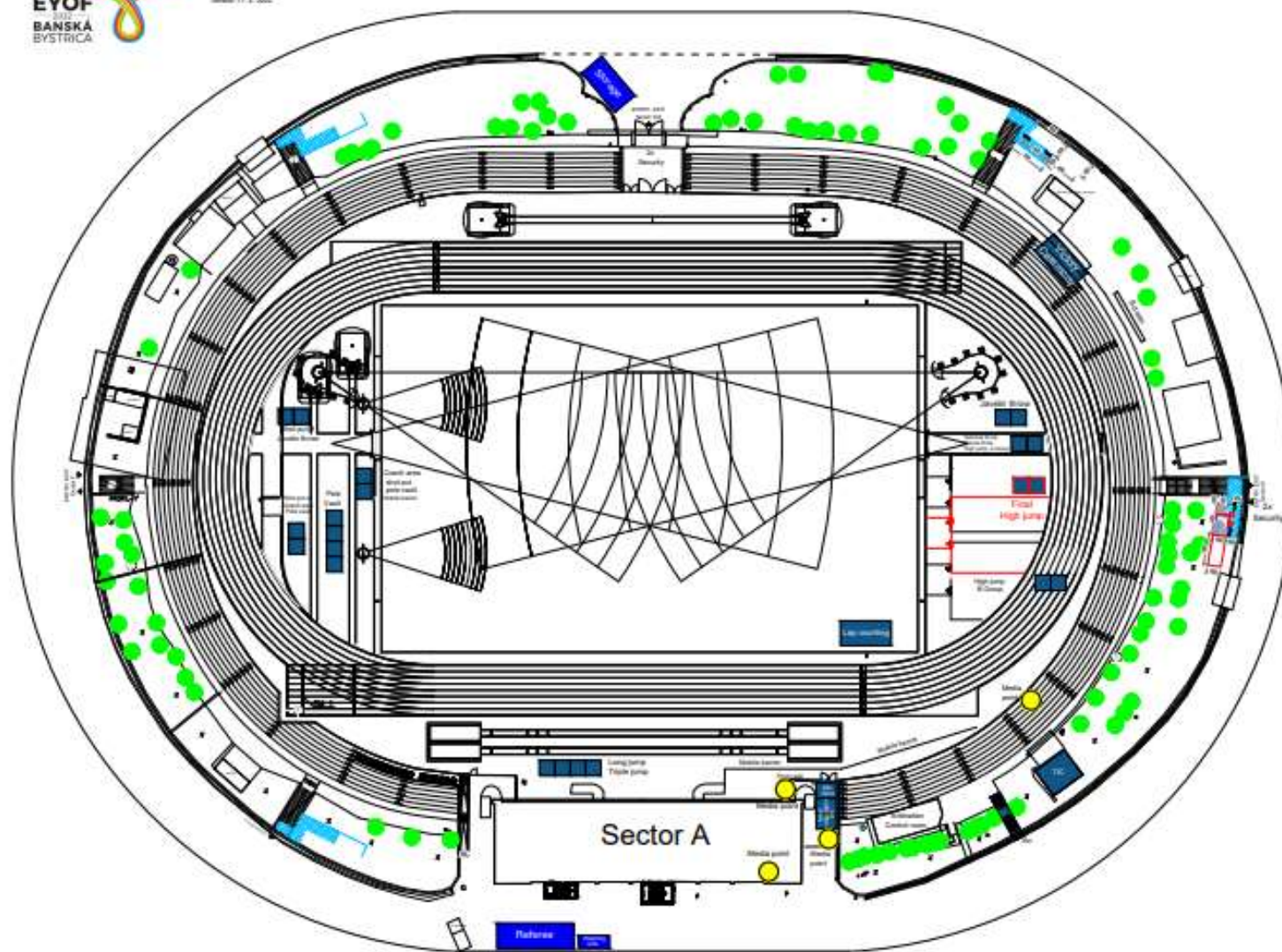
Appendix 4 Sport Park Athletics training venue

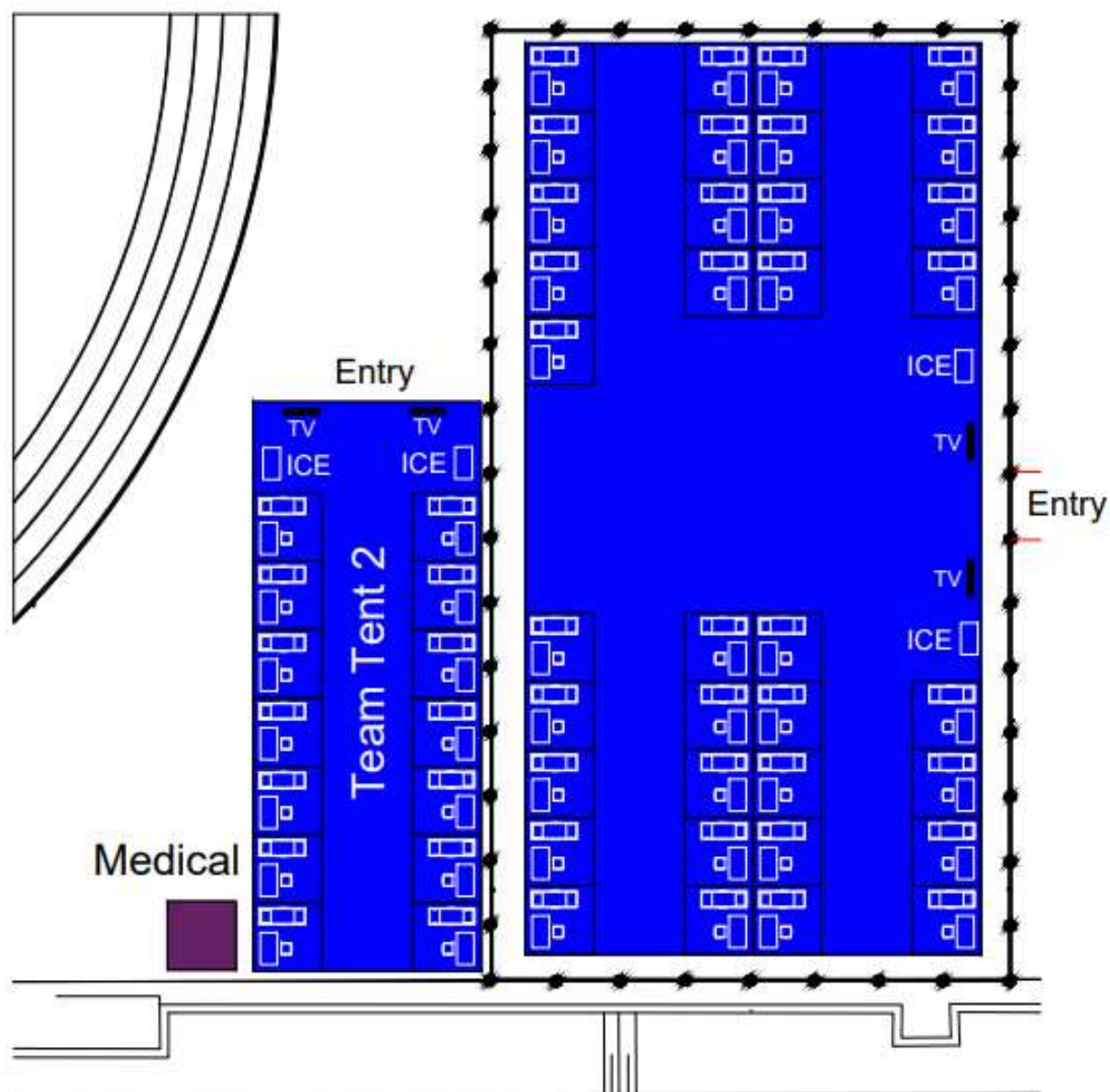
